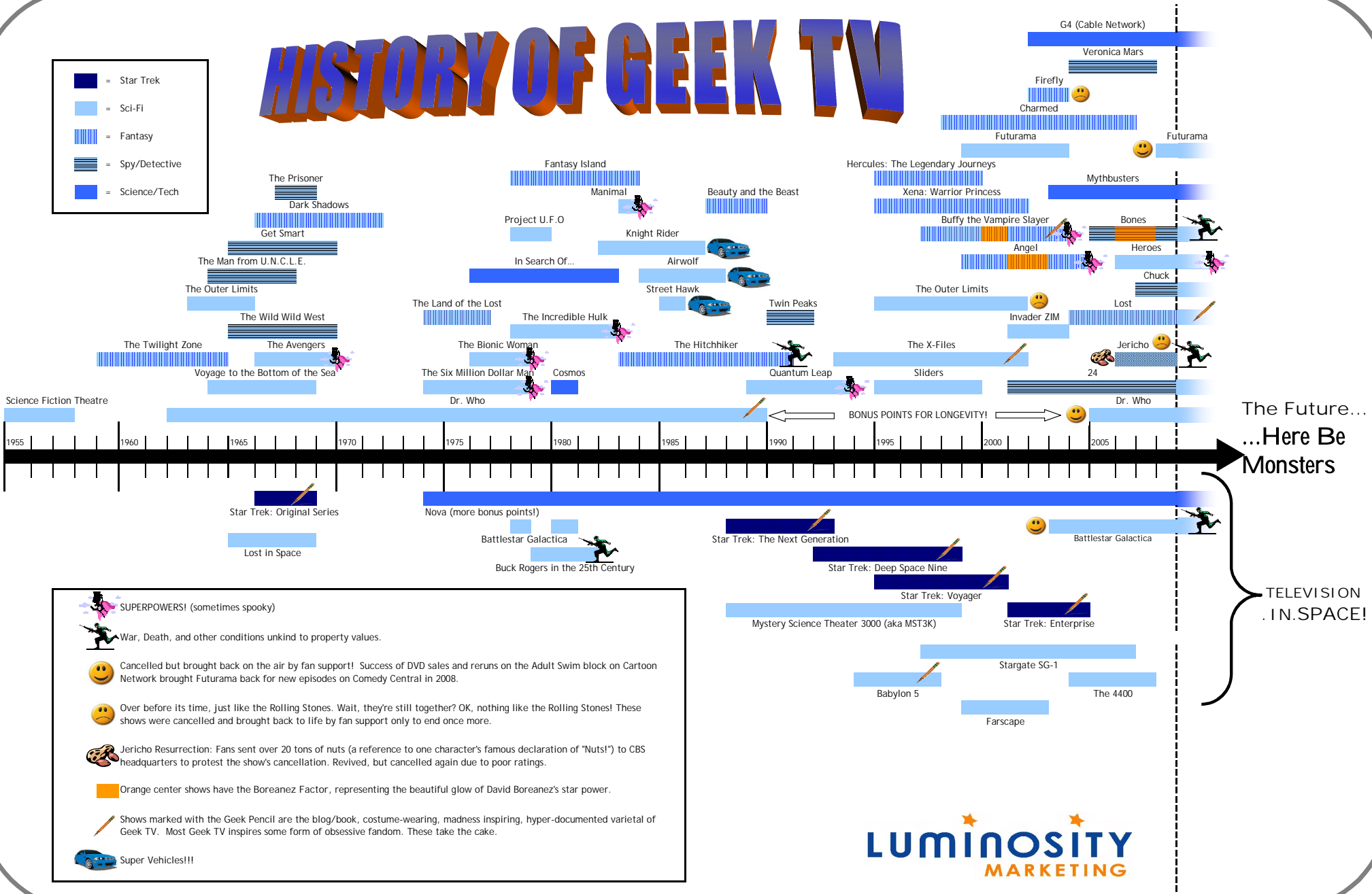










HISTORY OF GEEK TV
